

**SCHEME FOR WAIVER OF ADMISSION FEES, TUITION FEES ETC.
(BY GOVT. OF ASSAM)**

Vide letter No: AHE. 639/2018/11 Dated Dispur the 29th May, 2019

HIGHLIGHTS:

A. Applicability

1. The aim of the scheme is access to the poor students of the state and to help them achieve the benefits of Higher Education.
2. The scheme will be applicable to the students seeking admission into 1st year of HS/B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.
3. The scheme will also be applicable to the students seeking admission into 2nd year & 3rd year of HS/B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.
4. The beneficiary students under this scheme will have to pay College Magazine fees, Games & Sports fees and Festival & Cultural fees.

B. Eligibility

1. Students whose parental income is less than Rs. 2.00 lakh from all sources will be eligible to avail this scheme.
2. If either of the parent (mother or father) of the student is working in the State Govt./Central Govt./Semi Govt./State or Central Govt. undertakings, such students will not be eligible under this scheme
3. The Scheme is only for regular students having minimum **75% of attendance** in classes with no **back/arrear** paper in previous examination.

C. Proof of Income/Documents required

1. An Income Certificate from the Local **Revenue Circle Officer only**.
2. A declaration from the students that neither of the parents (mother or father) of the student is an employee of the State/Central Govt. or its undertakings.
3. Two Copies of photograph of sapling plantation by the student himself/herself. The students of 2nd year and 3rd year will have to submit a photograph of the same tree that was planted during previous year. The students admitted under the Schemes have to nurse the sapling till the 3rd year.

NB: 1) As per Govt. Guidelines the Admission Committee may enquire into the income of the family in case of doubts. Under such situation, if the committee finds that the income of the parents exceeds Rs. 2.00 lakh, the students will have to pay the entire fees of admission or the Committee may recommend cancellation of admission.

2) The College authority shall constitute a scrutiny committee and this committee shall scrutinize the authenticity of the plantation of the sapling by students.
