## IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO THE STUDENTS ADMITTED TO TDC SEMESTER SYSTEM

(ABSTRACT OF THE G.U. REGULATION)

- Student's Performance will be monitored throughout the semester by continuous assesment in the theory and practical courses. Evaluation of the students performance in each of the theory and practical paper will be based on the followings :  
Internal evaluation : 20% Marks  
External evaluation : 80% Marks
- Internal evaluation will be based on a sessional examination, home assignments, seminars and library works in each semester as prescribed by G.U.
- External evaluation will be through a final examination at the end of the semester.
- The pass marks in each theory paper is 30% and that in each practical paper is 40%
- In each paper students must secure pass marks in both the internal as well as the external evaluation separately
- A student who could not appear or failed in any semester examination will be allowed to clear the same as follows :
  - (a) 1st semester with the regular 3rd semester exam.
  - (b) 2nd semester with the regular 4th semester exam
  - (c) 3rd semester with the regular 5th semester exam
  - (d) 4th semester with the regular 6th semester exam
- A student may be allowed to "repeat " any one of the theory paper in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th semester and may be allowed for "betterment" of marks in one paper in the 5th semester provided the students secure less than 45% marks in that paper.
- No repeat/ betterment shall be allowed in the practical exams.
- A student must pass all his semester exams including repeat and betterment chanches within 05 Years from the date of admission in the 1st semester course. A student will get maximum 03 chances to clear a particular semester.
- In case of any dispute regarding evaluation or unforeseen events the matter may be placed in the committee of courses and studies (U.G.) for amicable sattlement
- Since the semester involves continuous assesment there would be no scope for a student to appear as a private candidate in any subject.



# an insight

Abhayapuri College, located in the heart of Abhayapuri town, the headquarters of North Salmara Sub-Division, is one of the oldest colleges in Assam. It came into existence on 13th August, 1955 as a result of the untiring efforts of some luminaries of this locality under the able leadership of Late Govinda Chandra Dev Sarma for their zeal for a higher educational institution in the administrative headquarters of the erstwhile Bijni Raj Estate. The people of Abhayapuri, Srijangram, Jogighopa, North Salmara, Bijni, Bongaigaon, Lengtisinga, Chakla, Kokila and other adjoining areas, although were not economically sound, contributed liberally in cash and kind to translate the dream of a college for their posterity into a reality. The name Abhayapuri itself came after the name of Ranee Abhayeswari, the Queen of the Bijni Raj Estate. Abhayapuri, surrounded by isolated hillocks, is a small town and called "Devadaru Nagaree" because of the scenic beauty of the Deodar trees standing majestically on both the sides of the main road. It is well known for its calm and clean environment as well as natural beauty.

Started as a single faculty Arts College affiliated to the University of Gauhati, the college came under deficit Grants - in - Aid system in 1962. With the opening of the Science stream in 1979, which was also brought under Deficit Grants - in - Aid system in 1986, the college attained a broader dimension in its stride for higher education. A host of highly qualified dedicated teachers has been imparting knowledge using modern methods and techniques to the students of this college, majority of which comes from its surrounding rural areas, as well as from the backward char areas.

Since the day of its establishment, the college had to pass many ups and downs; yet, due to the ceaseless efforts of the college authority with the active co-operation of the teaching and non-teaching staff and that of the students community and the public of this locality, it has attained the present prestigious position. It is a matter of pride that the college, in its glorious year of Golden Jubilee (2004), was assessed and accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), with 'B' Grade. The college celebrated its Golden Jubilee during August to Oct, 2005; and the college has become an institution of excellence for higher learning by this time. At present, the hallmarks of the college are regular classes, good results, periodic evaluation, strict discipline and friendly relationship of the teachers and students.

# Mission & Vision

The college, since its inception, carries the mission of imparting higher education to the students coming from surrounding backward areas in order to make them good and responsible citizens of the country. The college also looks for moral and intellectual upliftment of the students along with a persistent effort to provide peaceful environment for their academic pursuit.

The college, in its stride for higher education, has a vision for expanding its field of imparting higher education to make the students fit for modern competitive world and as a part of achieving this vision the college has made suitable arrangements for opening some career oriented courses, updated computer education of different categories and post graduate courses in some selected subjects. The college also doing its best for expanding the infrastructure facilities to cope with such academic growth.

The college has already been accorded provincialisation w.e.f. 2005 and it is managed by its Governing Body (G.B.) constituted by the Government of Assam as per provisions of The Assam Non-Government College Management Rules, 2001.

## SELECTION OF MAJOR SUBJECTS :

Candidates, willing to study a Major course in any subject mentioned above, will have to write clearly the subject, in the application form. However, They can write one more subject of second preference if there is a doubt for getting selection in the 1st preference in Major.

The selection list of the candidates offering Major, will be prepared on the basis of total marks obtained in the H. S. Examination plus the marks of the Subject, preferred for Major. A candidate, not selected for the subject of first preference, may be selected for the second one. However, the candidate, willing to study a Major Subject, must have to obtain at least 40% marks in H. S Examination, in the particular Subject/s. If a candidate is selected for major in two subjects of his/her preference he/she will get admitted according to his/her own choice.

The same process will be followed for selecting of candidates for offering Major in Science subjects as stated above for the Arts candidates.

It may be noted that a test will be held within one month from the date of admission, to assess the knowledge and skill of the students on the Major subjects.

## NUMBER OF SEATS :

The number of seats are limited as follows :

There are **150** seats in each of the H.S. 1st Year and 2nd Year **Arts**, and **75** Seats in each class of H.S. 1st Year and 2nd Year **Science**.

### PROCEDURE AND CRITERIA OF ADMISSION :

Application form for admission along within Prospectus are available in the College office during office hours on payment of 100/- (Rupees One Hundred Only). The forms will be accepted by the College, after it is duly filled up, within stipulated date.

The students are selected for admission strictly on the basis of merit. The applicants from other states will be selected by the Governing Body of the college as per Govt. Rules Subject to the availability of seats.

### RESERVATION OF SEATS :

- Some seats are reserved for the candidates belonging to SC /ST / OBC / MOBC/ Physically handicapped categories, as per Govt. rules.
- Total 20 (twenty) seats are also reserved for the students showing special performance in Games & Sports, NCC and other Co Curricular activities and these are filled up under the supervision of the Principal and G.B. President.

### COLLEGE HOSTEL :

The college has a Boys' Hostel and a Girls' Hostel with limited number of seats. Candidates willing to reside in the hostel should apply separately to the Principal, after the class admission is over.





## **DOCUMENTS TO BE CHECKED :**

Original Mark Sheets and Certificates (if any) of H.S.L.C. Examination onwards, will have to be produced at the time of interview and admission. A candidate, who has passed the qualifying Examination earlier than the current year has to produce a Gap Period Certificate, not exceeding two years, issued by the Head of the Institution where last attended / Gazetted Officer regarding his/her activities during the gap period. Three copies of pass port size photographs - one to be pasted on the top right corner of application form and another two copies for the Identity Card are to be submitted and Original Caste Certificate issued by the Govt. authority, if a candidate belongs to SC/ST/OBC/MOBC category is to be produced.

The Candidates from other states must produce valid documents including certified copy of Result Sheet published by the competent authority at the time of Admission. Moreover they should produce Migration Certificate within 06 months from the date of admission.

## **CASUAL ADMISSION :**


Casual admission into H.S. and TDC classes are also given to the students who detained in their respective final examinations. The dates of such admission are notified in due course. Generally the casual Admission is given after the Autumn Recess.

## **EXAMINATION AND ITS RULES :**

In addition to the Final Examinations conducted by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council and Gauhati University for H.S. and T.D.C. classes respectively, students will have to appear in the Sessional Examinations/ Unit Tests conducted by the Home Examination Board of the College as per instructions obtained from the council / G.U. The minimum marks to be secured by the students to pass the Test Examinations etc. are same as stipulated by the AHSEC and GU.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING UP OF FORMS FOR THE GAUHATI UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS, PART-I, PART II & PART III (For Annual System)**

1. A candidate appearing in Part - I/ Part -II/ Part -III Examination in all Subjects will fill in the form of Part - I / Part-II / Part-II Examination respectively.
2. (A) A candidate appearing Arrear / Repeat of Part-I along with Part-II will fill in only the Part-II form.

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- (B) A candidate appearing only in Part-I arrear / repeat paper will also fill in Part-II form.
3. (A) A candidate appearing in Arrear / Repeat of Part-II along with Part-III will fill in only the Part-II form.
- (B) A candidate appearing only in Part-II arrear / repeat paper will also fill in Part-III form.
4. A candidate who has not cleared Part-I Examination is not eligible to appear in Part-III Examination.
5. A candidate who appeared in Part -I Examination in 2009 and failed in Part-I Examination till 2011 or obtained arrear in a subject in 2009-2010 and could not pass the arrear subject till 2011 will not be eligible to sit in the Part - I Examination or arrear subject, as the case may be, in 2012. Such candidates will be required to appear in all subjects as fresh students in Part-I Examination in 2012.
6. Roll No. of all the previous Examinations of Part -I and Part -II (including arrear/ repeat, if any) should be clearly mentioned in the concerned clauses of Part -III Examination form.
7. Student appearing in all subjects of both Part-II & III simultaneously must intimate their Roll Nos. of Both the Parts to the Principal immediately on receipt of admit cards and the Principal will forward these in a lot of the Controller's office immediately after the Part-III Examination.

***N.B.:*** A candidate will get 3 chances in each Part but in all parts will get 5 Chances (Ref : G.U. Regulation 12). The college will not bear responsibility of any student who does not follow these rules until any modification is made by the G.U. Authority

### **ATTENDANCE :**

Regular and punctual attendance in the classes is obligatory. **As per G.U. rules, a student must attend at least 75% of the total lectures delivered in each subject during one academic session.** Otherwise, he/she will be debarred from appearing in the H.S. and TDC 1st & 2nd semester, Part-II & Part-III examinations.

### **COLLEGE UNIFORM :**

In order to have uniformity in wearing apparels, students of the college are to wear the uniforms, during college hours, as specified below for boys and girls separately

:

**FOR BOYS** : White shirt and Black Long Pant.

**FOR GIRLS** : Two different kinds of dress are prescribed for the Girls i.e, either 'Mekhela - Chadar' or 'Churidar - Kamiz' in the colour stated below :

- A. 'Mekhela' : Muga Colour; 'Chadar' : White Colour with Muga bordars (potti) and Blouse in Muga colour (plain).
- B. 'Churidar' and 'Churnee' (dopatta) : in white colour and Kamiz : in Muga colour.

## **S U P P O R T   S E R V I C E S**

### **COLLEGE CENTRAL LIBRARY :**

Abhayapuri College Library has well stacked collection of about 22,000 number of books, including Text Books, References and Encyclopaedia. The Library provides a good number of periodicals (Magazines and Journals of national and International recognition) and newspapers. There are separate reading rooms for the students and the teachers, in the library.

Internet and e-mail facilities along with Photostat and lamination services are also available in the College Central Library at a reasonable rate.

### **DIGITAL LANGUAGE LAB :**

A digital language lab has been established in 2011 with 11 computer and other necessary facilities aiming at imparting interactive language teaching in order to develop the communication skill of the students. The Lab is also opened for other interested persons.

### **COLLEGE HOSTEL :**

The College has Separate Boys' & Girls' Hostel with limited number of seats. Admission into the Hostel is given on the basis of merit and on payment of necessary fees.

### **CAREER GUIDANCE AND INFORMATION CELL :**

The career guidance and Information cell of the college guides the students in choosing a proper line of Higher Education with a prospect for suitable employment.

The cell prepares a series of awareness programmes including workshops to provide information about the opportunities for self-employment and entrepreneurship training.

### **EXTENSION EDUCATION CENTRE :**

The Extension Education Centre (EEC) of the college affiliated to G.U. promotes a meaningful and sustained support between the Higher Educational Institutions and the society. It includes Adult Education, Continuing Education, Population Education, Community Education etc, through field work activities. It is a two way process between the experts and the people to solve the social problems through Educational process. Extension Education will help students to face the challenges of the New Millennium. The Centre arranges health check up camp, awareness programmes on some dreadful diseases, for the poor people from time to time.

### **COMPUTER CENTRE :**

The college provides Computer Education to the students through its well-equipped computer centre which has introduced a number of Certificate and Diploma courses under the guidance of qualified Instructors.

Moreover, computer facilities are also available in some departments.

### **INTERNET & E-MAIL FACILITY:**

The college provides INTERNET & E-MAIL facility at the College Computer Centre.

### **GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL :**

The Grievance Redressal Cell of the college deals with various problems, complaints and grievances of students, principally regarding their campus lives.

### **SCHOLARSHIPS :**

National Scholarship, State Merit Scholarship and the Scholarships for the students belonging to SC / ST / OBC / MOBC/Minority Categories are available. There is also provision of UGC sponsored conveyance scholarship to SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/Minority/ Physically handicapped students who come from beyond 10 km radius of the college. The students qualified for these scholarships are to apply within the stipulated time to be notified in due course. The scholarship money is paid by A/C payee cheques.

### **STUDENTS' UNION :**

Abhayapuri College Students' Union is a body of the general students of the College and every student is a member of this body. The office bearers are elected



annually by the students through the “Election to the Students' Union” held as per Constitution of the Union. The Students' Union always extends co-operation to the college authority as well as the students to fulfill the objectives of the college.

**It is to be noted here that the hon'ble supreme court of India has directed the implementation of the recommendation of the committee (chaired by Sri J. M Lyndoh, Retd. CEC, India) to farm Guidelines on Students Election in colleges and universities. Some important directions of the Hon'ble court are mentioned below summarily.**

1. The Election will be held between 6 to 8 weeks from the date on commencement of the academic session.
2. The entire election process, starting from the date of filling the nomination papers, to the date of declaration of the results, including the campaigning period should not exceed 10 Days.
3. Only regular, fulltime students on the rolls of the college are eligible to contest the election.
4. Student between the age of 17 and 22 years may contest the election.
5. In no event the candidate should have any academic arrear in the year of contesting the election.
6. The candidate should have attained the minimum 75% attendance in class.
7. The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office bearer.
8. The maximum permitted expenditure of a candidate shall be Rs. 5000/- Each candidate shall have to submit complete & certified accounts (to be certified by the candidate) to the college authority within two weeks of the declaration of the result. The election of the candidate will be nullified in the event of any excessive expenditure.
9. No candidate shall be allowed to make use of Printed posters, printed pamphlets or any other printed materials for the purpose of canvassing. Candidates may only use hand made posters at the places in the campus notified by the Election Board of the college in advance.
10. The use of loudspeaker, vehicles and animals for the purpose of canvassing shall be prohibited.
11. All candidates shall be jointly responsible for ensuring the cleaning up of the



polling area within 48 hours of the conclusion of polling.

12. Any complaint or inconvenience of the candidates or voters should be reported to the Grievance Redressal Cell.

### **ALUMNI ASSOCIATION :**

Abhayapuri College Alumni Association is a Common platform of the ex-students of the College to associate with various developmental works of this institution. The association earnestly expects active participation in the programmes for making the college an excellent institution for Higher Education.

### **NSEP and NGPE :**

Abhayapuri College is a centre of National Standard Examination in Physics (NSEP) and National Graduate Physics Examination (NGPE), which are conducted by Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT), every year. The NSEP is the only examination for the students of H.S. level, leading to Physics Olympiad.

### **CHEMISTRY OLYMPIAD :**

There is a centre of the state level Chemistry Olympiad in the College, organized by the Society for Chemical Education, Assam annually. The Olympiad is conducted by the Deptt. of Chemistry of this College.

### **POOR - AID FUND :**

Poor students are provided financial aid for academic expenses from the fund raised by the G.B, teachers and general students of the college. The selection of the students for providing financial assistance is done by the college G.B.

### **BOOK BANK :**

The College Book Bank, which was attached with the College Central Library, is maintained separately for the benefit of the needy and meritorious students.

### **N.C.C. :**

The N.C.C. wing of the college is very active. A good number of Cadets are working under the guidance of a well trained officer (Lecturer). The Cadets regularly attend the Parades



relating to the Independence Day, Republic Day, College Foundation Day and take under some welfare projects like Adult Education, Blood Donation in addition to make rescue operation among the victims of any natural calamity and to create awareness of national integrity and communal harmony.

### **N.S.S. :**

National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of the College has been recognised as an unique agency in rendering social services both in and outside the College. Its workers have been able to earn national distinctions and win different Awards & Certificates in various fields and disciplines. They are working whole heartedly for the development of the society and observing different programmes of the Govt. for the national integration and communal harmony.

### **Bharat Scouts & Guides :**

The college has got a unit of the Bharat Scouts and Guides. It is a voluntary, social and educational movement for the young people of 16 - 25 years for the formation of their moral character and to make them good citizen. It is also a training for developing a sense of responsibility, self control, self reliance, self direction and sense of dedication for the well being of the nation, through which the students have been able to carry some national awards & certificates.

### **College Magazine and Wall Magazine :**

Abhayapuri College Magazine entitled, PRAYAS is brought out every year, which is edited by elected editor and sub-editor from the students under the guidance of an Editorial Board constituted with teachers & students. It publishes the views, opinions and the creative writings of the students. In addition to this magazine, there are a number of wall magazines displayed by different units, which provide the opportunity to enrich the literary talent of the students.

### **RESEARCH JOURNAL :**

The teachers of the college have used to published a teachers' journal annually under the guidance of "Publication and seminar committee" where topics on various research activities of the teachers and other informative articles from the teachers find places. Further, copies of the journal are distributed among the teachers' units of surrounding colleges.

### **RULES FOR MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE :**

- ◆ Students must abide by the rules and discipline of the college.
- ◆ Overall power for enforcement and maintenance of discipline are vested with the Principal and his decision shall be subject to the approval of G.B.
- ◆ A student is liable to disciplinary action like Compulsory transfer or Expulsion from the college for violating the college and the Hostel rules or adopting unfair means in the Examination Halls or Committing any other offences which are considered punishable by the authority.
- ◆ All notices desired to be pasted or circulated by the students anywhere in the College or Hostel premises shall require the approval of the Principal.
- ◆ Students must surrender their Identity cards to the college office at the time of receipt of the Pass or Transfer Certificate.
- ◆ Ragging is strictly prohibited within the college campus and in the college hostels. Violators will be punished as per rule.
